RE: Key Poll Findings—lowa Congressional District 2 Survey

Harper Polling conducted a survey of 406 likely voters in Iowa Congressional District 2 via landline and cell phone interviews conducted with live operators at a professional call center. The survey was completed July 26-28, 2020 and has a margin of error of +/-4.9%. The following memo covers key findings from the survey.

1. The race for Congress is tied in Iowa's 2nd Congressional District.

- Mariannette Miller-Meeks and Rita Hart each get 41% of the vote with 16% of voters undecided.
- Among voters who have an opinion of both candidates, Miller-Meeks leads Rita Hart 49%-46%.
- The race remains neck-and-neck with key voter segments, including No Party voters (35% MMM-37% Hart), high enthusiasm voters (43% MMM-42% Hart), and high propensity voters (42% MMM-43% Hart).
