RE: Results From A Survey In Minnesota's Seventh Congressional District

The Tarrance Group is pleased to present CLF with the summary findings from our recent survey of voter attitudes in Minnesota's Seventh Congressional District. Surveys among N=413 voters were conducted August 2nd-5th, and the margin of error is +/- 4.9%

Executive Summary

While a majority of voters like Collin Peterson, this latest poll indicates they are ready to throw him a retirement party and give a new person a chance as their representative in Congress.

Republican Michelle Fischbach is currently leading Congressman Collin Peterson on the ballot, 52% to 42%, with just 6% undecided.

Ballot Test

<u>Fischbach</u>	<u>Undecided</u>	<u>Peterson</u>
52%	6%	42%

Fischbach is known by 83% of voters across the district, with a 45% favorable and 20% unfavorable image.

Peterson is fully known (95% awareness) by voters here, with a 54% majority who say they have a favorable opinion of him, and 32% unfavorable.

Despite that, a 73% supermajority agree that his 28 years in Congress is long enough for any one person, and it is time to give someone else a chance. This sentiment is even held by a 58% majority of those who have a favorable impression of him
